It would have a hugely negative impact on this area, on traffic congestion that is already an issue, and on noise and air pollution levels which will be hugely detrimental to the health and well being of those of us that live here. - potential risk to our drinking water caused by development on a site where bromate is present. - the loss of a major part of the Ellenbrook Country Park, that has been such a lifeline for so many locals providing space to safely exercise in easily accessible, pleasant and open surroundings during the Covid pandemic. - if this proposal were to go ahead and the Gravel extraction plan be successfully appealed, it would mean the devastating loss of 90% of the Country Park."/>
