The subject site is located within the setting of a number of designated heritage assets which have not been adequately assessed within the documentation provided. The outline application is for a large-scale mixed-use development including 1100 new homes and supporting infrastructure including a primary school, local centre and open space with all matters reserved. Due to the size and scale of the proposed development is has the potential to harm the setting of a number of designated heritage assets.

In order to undertake an adequate assessment of the potential impact of the proposed scheme and for the Group to offer advice, the applicant should - in line with paragraph 189 of the NPPF - produce a heritage assessment which highlights the surrounding heritage assets and any contribution made by their setting.
