I am a resident of Pine Grove and have resided here for 20 years. Over the recent years the traffic flow, parking and inconsiderate driving has proven to have had a huge impact on residence. This is due to the school taking on more pupils from outer areas of Brookmans Park village. I have witness several traffic collisions some resulting in the emergency services being called out. Traffic is already excessive for the road and junction of Georges Wood road.

An expansion of the school would only cause MORE traffic flow and result in more incidents which could prove to be fatal.

The development is unattractive and on Greenbelt land. Pine Grove is not designed for such heavy traffic flow with 30mph speed almost always ignored. My driveway is often blocked by teachers, pupils and parents. None of which currently show any respect to residents. The proposed expansion will only add to the existing problem. Not enough parking spaces are proposed for the added number of staff intended.

The pollution of traffic from waiting vehicles will also have an impact and potentially dangerous. The Herts County Council website indicates NO need for expansion of school capacity in Brookmams Park. The school are also intending to go ahead with Academy Status Application which will lead to pupils travelling from afar.
