I am objecting to the prospect of building work at Chancellors School for the following reasons.

Traffic, safety, pollution issues.

I am unable to access or leave my house, between school opening and closing times. Due to traffic leaving Pine Grove and accessing A1000.

It is unsafe to walk at school times bearing in mind there is no pavement, therefore walking in the road is very dangerous because of the number of cars accessing the road and leading into Pine Grove.

Georges Wood Residents pay for the upkeep of our road, which continually needs repairing due to the coaches and cars that are turning and driving in the road. I do not think that the school contributes to this cost.

With more pupils coming into the school from different areas and further afield than Potters Bar this could have a security issue regarding burglaries etc.

I have lived in Brookman's park for nearly 40 years and from once being a small village it is now becoming more polluted and a major thoroughfare with cars using the school and pub and co-op.

Also, noise levels especially in the summer with traffic, music, etc. whilst not breaking the law. Again, it is a far cry from the quiet residential area that Estate Agents describe.

There is no public bus route for pupils or teachers to be able to use.
