Objection to Chancellor's School Proposed Expansion 2019

Why is the Council seeking to expand a school with a no Through Road? The additional car journeys involved are completely at odds with Central Government and Local Government Car Pollution Policy.

Plne Grove was only recently resurfaced after years and years of neglect but that does not overcome the existing Logistical challenges of Chancellor's.

1. Existing daily traffic disruption and congestion, parking in front of house drives,

parking issues with existing building developer's vehicles is already significant.

2. Application has no realistic Traffic Management Plan that meets additional pollution problems or for the additional volume of traffic. Classes, Sports plus Construction Traffic which will be substantial.

3. Application has insufficient Parking within school grounds. #33 new car spaces will be taken up by mostly by new staff.

4. Traffic Volume:

The Application has #7 classes x 30 Students plus the new Sports facilities = 200-300 additional car visits x2 a day. That is at least 600 additional car journey plus school supply vehicle journeys. It is totally unrealistic and would ignore the existing resident issues we all face.
