These changes to the first set of plans submitted make no difference to the impracticability of increasing the size and status of Chancellors School. From what was the original purpose of the school, i.e. of serving the children of the residents of Brookmans Park to what it has grown into, a school of over 1000 pupils from far and wide, now is the point at which any further expansion should cease.

Children, and the community would be far better served by not overloading the roads with needless journeys polluting the atmosphere transporting them from miles around. This is a residential area and highly rated as such but subjected twice daily to traffic of motorway proportions, including the inevitable jams due to the unsuitability of the location, not to mention the traffic which occurs out of general school hours, or the objectionable parking problems caused by the cars of staff and pupils of the school parked on both sides of the road and parents parked for protracted periods with their engines running. From an area of clean air (which government and society are clamouring for) this proposal contributes even more to the fumes and pollution, the unacceptable levels of which, we are now already experiencing. I strongly urge the Planning Authority to reject this proposal and let Chancellors School know it is already big enough for its present location
