Comments	This is simply not a sustainable site. It is remote from basic shops and services It is impossible to walk in safety in any direction from Firs Wood Close. There are no pedestrian footways on Coopers Lane Rd. This long lane is unlit, narrow and winding. As well as being a well used route by commuting motorists, hundreds of worshippers regularly attend the adjacent Jain Temple by car. Both cyclists and pedestrians are at significant risk of injury from the many fast moving cars on the lane. Additionally there is no bus service. The suggestion of walking along Hook Lane to Northaw is completely unrealistic. This is a long bridleway overshadowed by trees. Solo walkers would be very vulnerable as hidden from public view. I would never consider taking this route on my own. I do use it recreationally with walking groups. The terrain requires walking boots to be worn. Additionally there are minimal facilities to access in Northaw.
