Dear Planning Department

I write with regard to your letter of 24th June regarding a proposed development at land to the east of Firs Wood Close, Northaw - a proposal of 26 dwellings and associated access.

Fundamentally I do not agree with the applicant's planning consultants' application of national and local planning policy. My objections come from a deep desire to preserve the place in which I live.

I invite you down to our property to see the reality of the implications of this. Firs Wood Close has regulations in place on preserving the aesthetics of where we live so high fences/walls are not an option.

Furthermore, my neighbours, the Oshwal Centre, have developed a site based on their need for a peaceful and calm location in which we live in harmony. The appropriateness of siting community housing in this area is questionable.
