development- satisfactory (Shown on T J Evers Rev CPH&SP 1 of 2 28.10.19 plan) (d) the erection and maintenance of security hoarding including decorative displays and facilities for public viewing, where appropriate- satisfactory (e) siting and details of wheel washing facilities-satisfactory (f) measures to control the emission of dust and dirt during construction- satisfactory (g) a scheme for recycling/disposing of waste resulting from demolition and construction works- satisfactory h) construction vehicle numbers and type-satisfactory i) Construction access arrangements- - satisfactory j) Cleaning of site entrances, site tracks and the adjacent public highway- satisfactory k) Timing of construction activities to avoid school pick up/drop off times- satisfactory
