Thank you for your application requesting confirmation of compliance with the above condition.

Condition 9 (footway improvements)

Condition 9 of application ref: 6/2019/0857/MAJ is worded as follows:

9. Notwithstanding the details indicated on the submitted drawings hereby approved, prior to the first use of the development hereby approved, a detailed scheme for the provision of appropriate footway links between the site and the Stanborough Road junction and improvements to pedestrian facilities across the Stanborough Road access shall be submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority. These approved details shall also be implemented prior to the first use of the development.

REASON: To ensure construction of a satisfactory development and that the highway improvement works are designed to an appropriate standard in the interest of highway safety and amenity and in accordance with Policy 5, 13 and

21 of Hertfordshire's Local Transport Plan and the National Planning Policy Framework.

Whilst the wording of the condition required the improvements to the footpath to be implemented prior to the first use of the site, this was not possible due to the peak period during the school holidays. As such, the works were fully implemented at a later date and have now been completed. A section of the existing knee rail was removed to facilitate the use of a public footpath during the period preceding the footway improvements.
