Reason: To ensure construction of a satisfactory development and in the interests of highway safety in accordance with Policies 17 and 21 of Hertfordshire's Local Transport Plan (adopted 2018) CON2) Projecting Signage. The projection sign must be at a height of, or greater than 2.3 m vertically above the footpath and no less than 500 mm horizontally from the edge of the carriageway. Reason: The above condition is required in the interests of pedestrians/highway safety and in accordance with Roads in Hertfordshire: A guide for new developments, 3rd edition, Sect 4, Ch 1, (1.9).
