Good evening Mr Carter

Thank you for the copy email to Mr Freimanis.

I am grateful that, finally, the back shields are going to be installed on the perimeter lights. Please ensure they are placed immediately behind the light and not a couple of feet down the pole rendering it ineffective and that all the perimeter lights, as promised by Raymond Lee and Jonathan Boulton on 17 December 2021, will have back shields installed on them.

Please also place the back shields on the lights on the top deck in the correct place so it shields the lights properly.

Turning now to the car park lighting application, I am firmly of the opinion that you, as landowner, cannot open half a car park without the necessary consents. I trust you will do the right thing and not open it until the application for variation of the lighting has been heard at the DMC in June. The lights that are the subject of the variation are often on at night and should not be. No planning permission has been given for them to be installed let alone switched on.

With regards to the ASB management plan I note a second, more comprehensive, plan has now been produced. Whilst this is better, it still falls short of an adequate management plan.

The neighbouring properties need to be consulted and this has not happened. We also need to know who to contact and what the telephone numbers are. It is not sufficient to have it on a sign at the car park.

I look forward to hearing from you with confirmation that you will not open the car park until you have all the necessary consents.
