Having previously lived on Gresley Close and familiar with 'the cut through' in the current car park to the town centre I would feel intimidated and deterred from using the 'green spine' as shown. The council will I understand continue to own the land and has total control over this development. My fundamental objection is that I believe the council should commission family homes not more flats, especially given the number of flats already built or being built in separate commercial developments to the east of the railway."/>
