There are far too many flats being built, and their height of 5/6 floors is much too high. Also there are no social housing - which is desperately needed. The flats being built behind the terrace houses in Gresley Close are going to be 5 floors high - this will completely block out the light to these houses and infringe on their privacy too which is not fair. The flats near Waitrose are going to be 6 stories high which will be seen from the town centre - which will look awful/ugly. Also Bellway are only planning 0.6 parking spaces for each flat - which is ridiculous. We already have problems with not enough Doctors surgeries and having to wait 2 weeks to see a GP -with the population growing we will have more problems. We also need to have a guarantee that when building work starts there is a walkway from Gresley to the town centre."/>
