Thank you for consulting Hertfordshire Ecology on the above,

I am not aware of any significant ecological constraints relating to this application, However work should be carried outside of the main nesting season for birds (March to August inclusive) to protect breeding birds, their nests, eggs and young. If this is not practicable, a search of the area should be made no more than two days in advance of vegetation clearance by a competent Ecologist and if active nests are found, works should stop until the birds have left the nest."
