### **COMMENTS:**

Thank you for consulting the above application (Ref: 6/2024/1162/COND). This application submits CMP details for approval for conditions 1 and 24 that was applied to the grant of consent for 6/2019/3024/MAJ.

It appears that the condition 1 and 24 are identical which states that “No development shall commence until a Construction Management Plan has been submitted to and approved in writing by the local planning authority, in consultation with the Highway Authority. This should be based on the Hertfordshire’s Construction Management Template available from <https://www.hertfordshire.gov.uk/services/highways-roads-andpavements/business-and-developer-information/developmentmanagement/highways-development-management.aspx#managementplans>. The development shall be carried out in accordance with the approved Construction Management Plan”.

J. Dobkin has submitted a revised Construction Management Plan (CMP) dated 26-07-2024 for the development located at 29 Broadwater Road.

The revised CMP fulfilled the requirement of conditions 1, 24 and it has confirmed that the exiting access off Broadwater Road will be permanently closed off prior to first occupation under s278 agreement.

Thus, the Highway authority is content with the amended CMP and will be acceptable in the highway context
