In accordance with best practice guidelines and the advice contained in national policy, the operators are committed to undertaking wider engagement with the local community and other stakeholders who may have an interest in the development. The proposal has, therefore, been assessed using Traffic Light Rating Model in order to establish an appropriate level of engagement. The proposal has been categorised as green and we therefore have not carried out any wider community engagement although we did write to the local ward councillors.

We would be willing to meet to discuss the merits of the application, or to assist with any visits of the site and surrounding area, if this is beneficial to the determination of the application.
