<b>Comments</b>	<input type="text" value="It would be beneficial to install swift bricks on these houses, at least 1 per dwelling, rather than sparrow terraces on the garages for the following reasons: Swift bricks are a universal solution that will provide nest sites for not only swifts, but house sparrows and starlings too. Whereas Sparrow Terraces only cater for sparrows and the research shows that Sparrows do NOT readily use Sparrow terraces, even less so on low elevation sites such as garages. Any swift colonies nearby would benefit from an increase in nesting opportunities and help expand the colony as well and/or mitigate against any loss of existing nesting sites due to refurbishment of local houses that currently have swifts in their roof spaces. Swifts are currently on the red list of species of highest conservation concern and we should do all we can to help the population, as well as benefitting other struggling species mentioned above."/>
