if this is correct then the requirements will be for 5 x 1100litre containers to be emptied weekly at cost of **Second December** per container and 1 x set of mini-banks emptied fortnightly at cost of **Second Dece** Please note: I would strongly recommend you consider whether or not to place recycling facilities inside the bin store. Unfortunately if these banks become contaminated they will not be able to be emptied by our contractors and the management Company will have to pay to have them cleared or to arrange to clear themselves. not everyone shares the same ethos as far as recycling is concerned and when you have flats this can be an issue. in addition please bear in mind no excess or bulk items will be removed from the bin stores, any excess rubbish will again have to be cleared by the management company.
