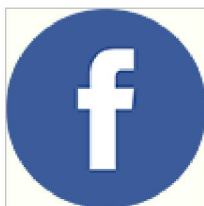
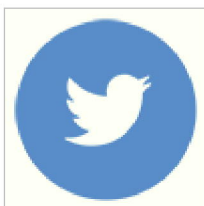

In relation to the report setting out the 'Case for Very Special Circumstances' document that was recently submitted and is being consulted on in relation to the above planning application, I would not wish to comment on whether the local sports need case would help justify making an exception to Green Belt policy in terms of the residential development. However, I would wish to advise that as set out in our original comments, the provision of an extension to the KGV Playing Fields and a financial contribution towards new or enhanced facilities is supported in principle and would be an appropriate way of the development meeting the additional outdoor sports facility needs that it generates and would also contribute towards meeting existing local outdoor sports facility needs.
