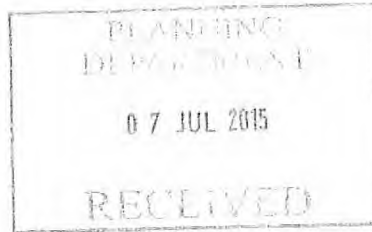

I am writing to object most strongly to the proposed buildings asking to be built on the King James V site in Cuffley.

This is on Green Belt land when there are several brownfield sites available around in the Cuffley area which could be used instead of once again encroaching on our lovely countryside.

I do not consider enough thought has been given to the infrastructure in the area and particularly to the amount of increased traffic this is going to add to the district. Already at rushhour the traffic is at a complete halt and yet I have been told the way to alleviate this is to add bollards through the village high street. In my opinion this cannot in anyway solve this problem when the amount of traffic which can increase from this site is going to aggravate this further.

The parking for the shops in the village is already horrendous and with another estate adding to the number of cars using the shops will be unbelievable. The station car park is already full so I cannot see how that can accommodate any more commuters.

I sincerely hope that common sense will prevail in making a long term decision about this time when there could be other alternatives.
