I would like to register my objection to the Tesco plan. Whilst something needs to be done to improve the site I do not believe that the Tesco plan would be appropriate. My main objections being:

1. The Tesco development would draw business away from the Town Centre at a time when we already have a number of units standing empty.
2. With Waitrose, the new Sainsbury store and Morrisons close by, Welwyn Garden City has no need for another Food Retailing Superstore
3. Studies have shown that significant congestion would result from this plan.

My view is that we need to find another developer who would provide the housing and amenity benefits without the imposition of another Superstore.
