We are committed to extensive consultation and will be holding a series of public exhibitions in Welwyn Garden City. We would be delighted if you would be able to attend. Here are the details:

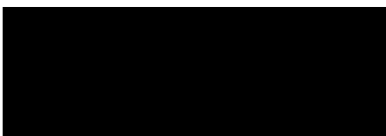
