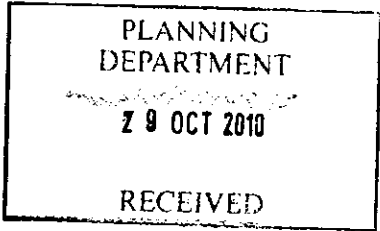

I would like to express my strong support for Tesco's planning application for the above site.

I should explain that I work for Tesco as a data protection lawyer based at its HQ in Cheshunt. However, I live in Welwyn Garden City with my wife and two young children and am responding to the application in my personal capacity.

In my view, the planned regeneration of the site by Tesco should bring significant benefits for the town:
