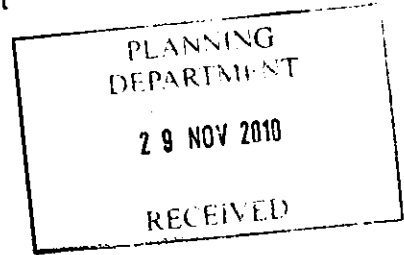

I would like to express my support for planning application N6/2010/2055/MA.

The application site is located adjacent to Welwyn Garden City centre with direct access being provided by the footbridge which runs over the mainline rail line and into the Howard Centre. The proposed use of the site will enhance the existing city centre, particularly with regard to the proposed A3 aspect of the scheme. The city centre suffers from a lack of choice with regard to restaurants and a well planned addition to the current small selection would be welcomed.

The proposed leisure facilities and the heritage centre are likely to be well used by the city's residents and will expand the range of activities currently available in the city centre. I am also of the opinion that more people as a whole will be attracted to the city centre if the scheme is successful, as customers and visitors alike use the facilities available on the application site before crossing the footbridge into the Howard Centre or vice versa.
