THE STANDARD CONDITIONS.

- (1) All advertisements displayed, and any land used for the display of advertisement, shall be maintained in a clean and tidy condition to the reasonable satisfaction of the local planning authority.
(2) Any hoarding or similar structure or any sign, board or device erected or used principally for the purpose of displaying advertisements shall be maintained in a clean and tidy condition to the reasonable satisfaction of the local planning authority.
(3) Where any advertisement is required under the Town and Country Planning (Control of Advertisements) Regulations, 1969, to be removed, the removal thereof shall be carried out to the reasonable satisfaction of the local planning authority.
