I had Tree works application for 15 Sherrades Park Road. The original application asked for crown reductions and thinning and I thought the thinning works were not appropriate. Having spoken to the applicant it was clear that they were looking to reduce all the trees rather than thin, they emailed a revision to the works requested and I approved this, however the approval notice is for the original works. Subject: 15 Sherradspark Road Welwyn Garden City – N6/2008/2209/TE and N6/2008/2210/TC – 25% Crown Reduction to oak trees T1 and T2. 15% Crown Reduction to oaks T3 and T4.

I have been to the above property to inspect the trees at the above property with regards to the recent application for tree works.

The trees in question are located in the rear garden of 15 Sherradspark Road. There has been an amendment to the original request for works from the applicant via e-mail (a copy of the email is attached with this memo). This memo deals with the revised application only.

T1 is a mature oak. This tree recently has lost some limbs in the recent snow fall last October. From its appearance this tree looks to have been crown reduced in the past. The applicant wishes to crown reduce this tree by 25%. In light of the recent damage to the tree and its past management this work would be appropriate.

T2 is a mature oak adjacent to the boundary with no.13 Sherradspark Road. This tree has recently shed a branch into the neighbours garden and has a spreading crown which is encroaching into the garden of no 13. During my inspection I noted some deadwood within its crown. The applicant wishes to crown reduce this tree by 25%. In light of the recent damage to this tree and its spreading crown a 25% crown reduction would be appropriate.

T3 and T4 are both mature oaks which have been reduced heavily in the past. The applicant wishes to crown reduce both trees by 15%. As these trees have been reduced in the past this work is appropriate.

The above works should be carried out either over winter or in high summer and to current best practise standards to minimise the impact in the tree.
