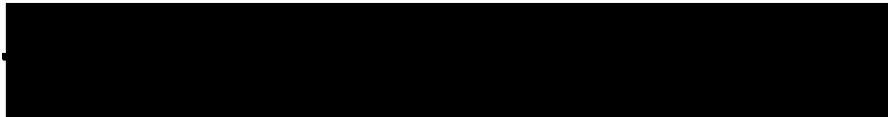

I am writing to object to the proposed extension to the council offices. I live in the conservation area and one of the things I love about WGC is the architecture and landscaping.

The proposed exterior is not in keeping with surrounding buildings and not in keeping with the conservation area. The big blob of glass and concrete is ugly and reminiscent of monstrosities built in the 1970s. The design does not reflect the context, materials, proportions or scale of the original building, which was award winning when built.

Furthermore I believe you have broken your own rules on conservation. If I wanted to build a great big glass wall across the front of my house, would you let me? I think not.

Finally, as a council tax payer I am deeply concerned about the cost of this project.
