We object to the Council Office Extension planning application on the following grounds:

1. The building is in the conservation area. The planned extension is not subservient to the existing building and does not respect its materials and setting.
2. The proposed exterior is out of sympathy with the original building.
3. Comfort levels will depend entirely on artificial light and ventilation, resulting in unnecessary use of energy. Occupancy of some floors will be too dense.
4. The planning application contains a number of errors and cannot have been validated with due care and attention or these errors would have been removed. The most laughable error is that the energy consultant seems to believe that he was dealing with St Albans and District City Council.
