Comment: The cycling statements made in the Transport Statement and Sustainability Checklist are completely wrong.

There are NO cycle paths to the Campus East Building. Why were these documents not rejected ?

WHBC must take walking and cycling seriously and provide quality infrastructure that is enjoyable and safe to use.

They must put in the funding and effort to design and build this properly, rather than just squeezing in poor quality paths only if there is room to do so.

So - as part of this project build a shared use cycle path on Bridge Road.
Relocate the Bus Stop to the southern side of the Campus East Offices.

Within the Campus roundabout, widen the 2 existing paths and create an additional wide path to directly connect the north pedestrian crossing to the east pedestrian crossing.

Remove the hedges and flower beds as required, to create a new safe wide cycle path all the way around the Office building.

Provide many more additional cycle racks at the front for the public and at the rear for employees.

When the above works are completed, create a good quality surface on the disused railway under the White Bridge going east-west, (removing the existing large heaps of soil which make access difficult), through Oaklands College to join Sherrardspark directly with College Way, Campus East Offices and Bridge Rd.
