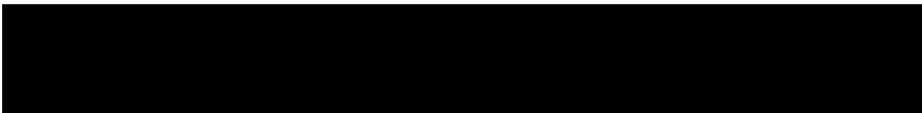

Dear Sirs

I object to the above proposals for the following reasons:-

- 1 This is in a conservation area and therefore any extension should respect the materials and setting and be subservient to the existing building. The aim should be to maintain the Garden City ethos.
- 2 There appear to be deficiencies in the internal design resulting in cramped office accommodation and a split-level Council Chamber which could lead to an "us and them" situation.
- 3 The Council appears to have broken its own rules in validating its own application and in not allowing the proposal to go out for public consultation.

I feel that the whole scheme should be reviewed in terms of obvious unsuitability for a Garden City location and for seemingly being a rushed and ill-considered use of public money.
