I write to you to express disappointment at the visual appearance of the proposed office extension that is being taken forward for planning permission. The building is in a conservation area and the expectation is that there would have been every effort made to ensure that the appearance of the building was sympathetic with the surrounding buildings and with the ethos of the town. Instead your architect has produced something of a 'carbuncle' that defaces a pleasant building and is totally out of keeping with its surrounds. For the council to be proposing such a building must raise real concerns that it has any motivation to protect the unique character of the town generally. The new McArthy and Stone Retirement apartments on the Campus prove that with sympathetic design it is possible to construct a modern building that fits its surroundings. The design of the office extension is the very antithesis of this. I would urge you to ditch the current design and get hold of an architect who can put together a design that we can look on with pride and not disgust and disappointment.
