

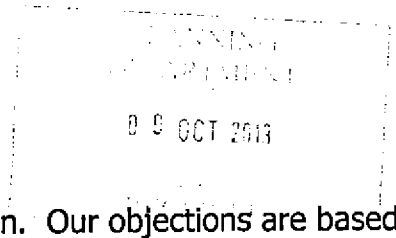

We write to strongly object to the planned Council Office Extension. Our objections are based on:

1. The exterior which bears no relation to the rest of the building, or indeed to those regulations laid down for residents to abide by. Strict rules are laid down for residents in the conservation area and indeed throughout the town, why should the Council be exempt and why on earth would they want to have this eyesore attached to the very heart of the town buildings.
2. What we have read about the proposals for the interior, appear to indicate inadequate accommodation. Working conditions for staff will depend entirely on artificial light and ventilation resulting in high energy consumption and running costs at a time when energy conservation is of the utmost importance.
3. The planning application which appears to have been received and validated on the same day, is unfair and an abuse of the process. The consultant employed appears to think he is dealing with St Albans, not Welwyn Garden City and has obviously not visited the town recently in view of the fact that he thinks the Police Headquarters are still in situ when a quick glance would reveal the newly built Peel Court.

These are just a few of the points of concern that as long-term residents we are anxious should be conveyed to the Council.
