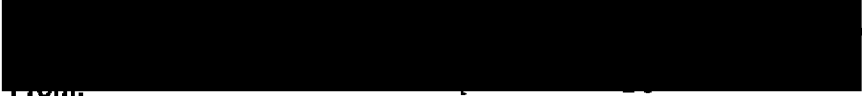

As I was writing before I accidentally hit the "send" button, the design is totally out of keeping, especially as it is right in the middle of the Conservation Area. Building materials are most "unsympathetic" with those normally insisted on by the Council themselves.

Details of the interior suggest little or no thought has been given to the comfort or welfare of the staff who would be working in the building, and must surely contravene HSE regulations.

The planning application appears to have been rushed through with no transparency or public consultation. As we're the local Council Tax payers, we are surely entitled to our say as to what is built in our town. Considerable pressure is put on residents to respect the building style when applying to have extensions built. Presumably the Council should practice what it preaches.
