Hello and, as you are a member of the Council committee that handles Planning applications, as well as being a councillor for Peartree ward (where I live), I would like to let you know that I am unhappy with the planning-application that has been submitted to extend the Council offices, in Welwyn Garden City (reference N6/2013/1938/MA).

I have filed an official objection and one of the points that I have raised, in my objection, is the fact that the application seems to fly in the face of the Council's own guidelines, for developments that are in the town's Conservation area, and this proposed development is in that area. The guidelines require an extension "to respect the materials and setting and to be subservient to the existing building", which the proposal does not do.

Hopefully, when the application is dealt with, you will mention this point and vote for rejection, of the application.
