I should like to object again in the strongest possible terms to the proposed amended extension plans to the Council Offices on the Campus. It is not outrageous that the Council allows itself to ride roughshod over the rules it applies to others within the conservation area of the Garden City.

The previous extension in 1978 remains an eyesore because of the nature of the windows, which do not sit well beside the original building style. This latest glass, flat-topped extension is far worse and I can only hope the Council planners will think again before ruining further the appearance of the Garden City centre.

I have lived in WGC since my marriage in 1962 and enjoy what it has to offer but this proposed development is totally out of keeping with the rest of the surrounding buildings. The amended plans do not help at all.
