I object to the proposed extension on the basis that it does not abide by the Council's own rules covering extensions in the Conservation Area.

If the present proposal is constructed, residents in the Conservation Area will only bear contempt for these rules in planning their own extensions.

For a project of this nature and cost, full public consultation should have been carried out and clearly this has not happened.
