Sir

Whilst I am grateful that some of the comments made by myself and others have been taken into account in the redesign of the extension I am very disappointed that the changes do not address the real concerns that have been raised. The design is still completely out of character with the rest of the building and, most importantly, it is still not in keeping with the designs generally used for buildings within the Conservation Area.

I reiterate an earlier comment that I made. If I, as a householder had both the temerity and lack of appreciation to submit such a design for the extension to my house (and I never would because I respect the design principles that underlie all the buildings in this area) then I would expect the Council to turn me down flat. It is extremely galling to me as a resident that you do not appear to apply the same standards to your own proposals as you do to others.

I would therefore ask you, again, to look at this again and come up with a proposal that not only fits the Council's requirements for an extension, but which also fits in with the overall design ethos for a very important building in the middle of the Conservation area.
