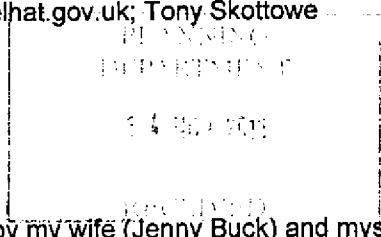

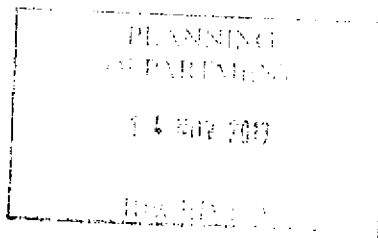

My wife and I wish to object most strongly to the Council Office extension proposed under the reference above.

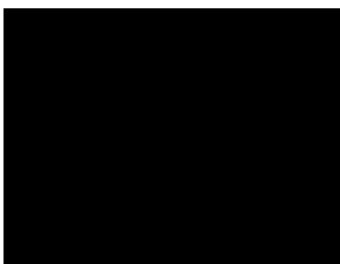
We note that there have been changes to the plans but, as far as we are concerned no account has been taken of what we feel are insensitive and inappropriate architectural additions to the Council Offices.

It is exactly the type of design that any resident or business in the centre of Welwyn Garden City - who applied for planning permission - would find that application instantly dismissed. It appears that therefore there is one rule for the Council and another which applies to residents or businesses. This is grossly unfair and unjust.

With respect to the design, we find it unbelievable that architects should have been instructed in such a way that creates a building showing little respect for the context, materials, proportions or scale of the original building.

Please would you register our objection and do your best to make sure that the whole project is reviewed or preferably cancelled altogether.
