

This proposal seems inconceivable to us that permission for this would be given as the digester is currently being monitored by the Environment Agency for nuisance odours. These foul odours have been detected as far away as Morrisons Supermarket on the A10. It is possible that this digester is in danger of being closed down as a public nuisance so it is futile at this time to continue with this proposal. During this year we have had numerous bowls matches cancelled or abandoned at Northaw & Cuffley Bowling club due to the STINK and have not been able to venture into our garden.

We do not know what damage is being done to peoples' health that this plant may be causing. The storage lagoon has been pronounced "not fit for purpose" and has been served with an anti pollution works notice by the Environment Agency

There is no evidence that this system works and to rely on this for any development site is crazy

We urge the planners to not to give permission for this proposal as this will change the rural ambiance of the area forever and what is gone can never be replaced
