Northaw Road East (Cattlegate Farm)


Please refuse planning permission for the above installation. The lagoon and other installations which would feed this are of great concern to the Environment Agency. They have reported that the structural stability of the storage lagoon is not fit for purpose and have served an Anti Pollution Works Notice on the owners to remove the potential risk of environmental harm.

They continue to receive large numbers of odour complaints and we are unsure whether this is affecting the health of the residents of Cuffley, Goffs Oak and indeed Enfield. We know Enfield Council have also received odour complaints.

This installation will be totally unnecessary if planning permission is refused for the over development of green belt land at Northaw Road East, Cuffley. If you do give permission for this pipework this will pave the way for this unpopular and unwarranted housing development which will totally spoil the rural ambience and workings of our village life.

Nobody who lives in Cuffley wants this. We beg you to please work for us ratepayers and refuse this on our behalf. Please do not collude with the developments.
