Comments	<input type="text" value="14/05/2018 - Lorraine Davis Can be incorporated onto existing ARRC scheme. The bin store would have to be designed so that there is clear access in front of and adjacent to the gates at all times so Parking prohibited, which must open outwards and have smooth unrestricted path to freighter i.e. no kerbs, cobbles etc. The requirement would be for 1 x 1100l container at ?390.00 emptied weekly and 1 x MRC for glass/cans and papers (optional) at cost of ? 560.00. There are recycling facilities close by in the car parks at Sainsburys or at the Campus West so these banks may be a better option. This would reduce the risk of contamination of the recycling bins which would result in non-emptying. If bins become contaminated they would need to be either sorted to remove contamination or a payment would need to be made to empty into landfill. The gates of the store should have a lock preferably coded rather than fob or key to avoid flytipping by others."/>
