My husband and I would like oppose the application for the planned development as it stands

We live at the sheltered housing estate Home Ley/Home Meadow, moved here to spend our latter years in somewhat security with companion neighbours

I and many tenants on this sheltered housing estate have illness and some illnesses are complex and people cannot get out much

It appears our flats and bungalow will be overpowered by flats proposed to be built, the proximity is too close

Elderly people spend a considerable time at home because of infirmity and illness and will be completely overpowered by the proposed flats. As tenants we do not want to have to keep curtains half closed obscuring the outside and light to give us privacy

We are so close to the road - Peartree Lane we actually overlook it our flats are extremely hot and will be unable to open any windows through noise and dust/dirt.

Peartree Lane has now become a cut through and extremely busy with speeding traffic and builders vehicles from 6am demolition lorries will be unbearable. We have to witness constant arguments and vehicle hooters and near misses (crashes) at the chicane at present

The doors and windows on our flats are not noise and dust friendly
