Reason: To ensure construction of a satisfactory development and in the interests of highway safety in accordance with Policies 17 and 21 of Hertfordshire's Local Transport Plan (adopted 2018)

COMMENTS The proposals are for the replacement signage to main building facade and entrance canopy including 1 x illuminated projecting sign, 1 x non-illuminated fascia sign 1 x non-illuminated freestanding sign. Campus roundabout is classified and provides a secondary distributor function in the road hierarchy. The vehicle speeds past this site are limited to 30mph. There have been five recorded accidents in the vicinity of the site (although not linked to access) a rolling 5-year period. PLANNING HISTIORY The application site has previous planning N6/2013/0058/AD COMMENTS: Given the proposal involves the installation of one externally illuminated signs the above recommended conditions will ensure that drivers of vehicles along the adjacent public highway are not dazzled or distracted, prejudicial to highway safety Subject to the informatives and condition the highway authority would not wish to restrict the grant of planning permission.
