# Whether the tree(s) merit a Tree Preservation Order

An assessment is required of the amenity value of the tree(s) and whether it/they help to preserve the character or appearance of the conservation area.

The assessment considers the condition of the tree, its retention span, relative public visibility and other factors – such as, but not limited to, whether it is part of a group, has historical importance and, has good form.

## T1 Liquidamber

The trees condition and suitability is considered to be good with a remaining useful life expectancy of approximately 20-40 years. The trees overall size can be classed as medium with clear visibility to the public.

### T2 Hornbeam

The trees condition and suitability is considered to be good with a remaining useful life expectancy of approximately 100+ years. The trees overall size can be classed as large with a limited visibility to the public.

#### T3 Maple

The trees condition and suitability is considered to be good with a remaining useful life expectancy of approximately 20-40 years. The trees overall size can be classed as medium with a limited visibility to the public.

#### T4 Mountain Ash

The trees condition and suitability is considered to be dead with a remaining useful life expectancy of approximately less than 10 years. The trees overall
