Comments	<input type="text" value="1) It is an over development of the site & poorly reflects the character within the Conservation Area of Welwyn Garden City. 2) It fails to retain the appearance or enhance the character of this part the Garden City adjacent to Sherrardspark Wood. 3) Back filling of the properties set a dangerous precedent in the Conservation Area. 4) 52/54 Bridge Road were built for workers on the Panshanger Estate in 1876 pre-dating the formation of Welwyn Garden City. These cottages and others close by have historical significance and development to the rear will harm the setting of these cottages. Welwyn Garden City is known worldwide as one of the finest examples of garden city design. Visitors from all over the world (including planners and academics) come to tour the town. It would be tragic to damage that heritage. 5) In addition, although application N6/2014/2504/FP in 2014 was granted, more recently 6/2019/0879/FULL in 2019 and 6/2020/1837/FULL in 2020 were refused."/>
