| Comments | <input type="text" value="1. Like the other two Broadwater Road proposals under consideration, this is completely out of keeping with the whole ethos of the Garden City. I moved here from NW London, from a flat in a low-rise building dwarfed by surrounding high-rise blocks. I would be very saddened to see that sort of development repeated here. 2. The proposed blocks are much too high for the restricted area in which they will be positioned, and will completely alter the skyline of the town. 3. High-density housing in the Broadwater area will do the town no favours. 4. There is complete disregard for the necessity for new infrastructure (education, health, recreational) that a development like this would entail. 5. There are other sites within the borough, including villages with high public transport accessibility, which appear to have been ignored despite their suitability for development."/> |
