Comments	<input type="text" value="I feel that the planning applications in the Broadwater Road area are wholly incompatible with the Council's own plan for the area. The proposed buildings are too high, the proposed population density is too great and the proposed proportion of social rented housing is too low. If the Council officials have recommended that these planning applications should be approved, you should replace your Council officials. If the Council officials have recommended that the planning applications should be turned down, but the Councillors are minded to approve them, then the Councillors should be replaced - and the next local elections will of course provide an opportunity to do so. The Welwyn Garden City Society has made clear that the planning applications are objectionable. The Council must make a stand and insist that only planning applications which are consistent with the Council's plan for the area should be approved."/>
