It will be out of keeping with the rest of our town, and importantly, will not provide for enough parking. We are already experiencing severe problems with parking in some parts of the town (made worse by the Council's recently enforced restrictions), and the planned number of parking spaces per dwelling at the proposed site will simply create an unresolvable problem in the future. I strongly object to the Bio Park planning proposal, which must be restricted to preserve our town as a garden city. Thank you."/>
