Comments	<input type="text" value="I object to this application, it is not in keeping with the Garden City ethos:- 9-storey buildings are not suitable buildings for our beautiful town. The plans are ill conceived. We do not have the infrastructure to support these plans:- no hospital & insufficient doctors surgeries. Lister hospital is over-loaded, it cannot support more people. There are insufficient schools, parking spaces and bus services. The planners 'claim', of following the ethos of the Garden City, is flawed - high rise (7-9 storey) apartment blocks, with black framed windows and roof gardens are ugly - not what the wider community want. WGC residents want houses with gardens and car spaces. Not 'hubs' to meet in! Plus it is misguided too assume only 1/2 of all residents will use cars - cars will be essential as transport services are so poor, so there will be more cars not less! WGC residents are not avid cyclists. Leafy views through these sites is not sufficient - this is a Garden City !! Not a Metropolis."/>
